

**PREDIBASE, LLC**  
**ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY**

This Predibase Acceptable Use Policy (“**AUP**”) governs Customer’s use of the Service (as defined in the Agreement), and forms part of the Predibase Service Agreement, or equivalent agreement between Customer and Predibase governing Customer’s use of Predibase’s product offerings (“**Agreement**”). All capitalized terms not defined herein are as defined in the Agreement.

Customer agrees that it will not:

- interrupt, or attempt to interrupt, violate, breach, or compromise the operation or security of the Service or any networks or systems;
- use the Service to harass any person, cause damage or injury to any person or property or the environment, or publish any material that is false, defamatory, harassing, or obscene;
- use the Service to generate, distribute, publish or facilitate unsolicited mass email, promotions, advertisings, or other solicitations (“**Spam**”);
- use the Service in any manner that may be unlawful or gives rise to civil or criminal liability, or in violation of any export law or regulation;
- use the Service in a manner that violates or infringes upon the intellectual property, privacy, or publicity rights of any person or entity;
- perform or disclose network discovery, port and service identification, vulnerability scanning, password cracking, or penetration testing of the Service, or otherwise disable, interfere with or circumvent any aspect of the Service;
- take any action that may disrupt or is likely to damage, disable, or overburden the Service infrastructure;
- upload, use, or otherwise make available any Customer data that contains viruses, worms, Trojan horses, corrupted files, hoaxes, or other items of a destructive or deceptive nature;
- use the Service to try to gain unauthorized access to or disrupt any service, device, data, account, or network; or
- use the Service except in conformance with the allocations and amounts subscribed to in the applicable Order.
